Despite spending far more on healthcare than other high-income nations, the U.S. scores poorly on many key health measures, including life expectancy, preventable hospital admissions, postoperative complications, and maternal mortality. A recent OIG Report stated gains in patient safety have stalled over the past decade contrary to what the patient safety organizations have been saying.
