Approximately 1 of every 25 hospitalized patients in the United States has a hospital infection, meaning that nearly 650,000 patients contract one of these infections each year during the course of their treatment. The infections occur in intensive care units (ICUs), neonatal ICUs, and medical, surgical, and medical/surgical ward locations. 100 SafeCare Hospitals report hospital-specific infections rates for the following 7 measures:
