LEXINGTON, KENTUCKY, USA, November 25, 2024/SafeCareGroup.com/-- SafeCare magazine is celebrating its 10th Anniversary edition. After a full decade, the monthly publication is fulfilling its mission of sharing stories of people, places, and technology to improve the human condition.

The publication started out in August 2015 as a quarterly (four times a year publication) aimed solely at healthcare and hospital audience. Since its first edition, Healthcare's Black Tuesday, the magazine focused exclusively on persons, events, and places in the healthcare industry. The purpose was to draw attention to some of the most pressing healthcare issues featuring several industry personalities and topics.

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In addition, since 2015, there has also been a lot of changes in the media world, especially as relating to printed publications. Perhaps, the most significant change was influenced when the world experienced the COVID-19 pandemic. SafeCare magazine has undergone significant changes too.

At the start of the pandemic, SafeCare magazine attempted to continue with printed paper copies. The magazine implemented deliveries with plastic bag containers, to avoid cross contamination issues and spread of the COVID virus. One of the consequences of doing so was increased mailing cost. There were also issues of captured moisture that damaged several deliveries to subscribers. As a result, SafeCare magazine switched to an all-electronic, downloadable format.

Other changes were also forthcoming. The magazine’s editorial board decided to broaden the scope of topics offered. Politics, group purchasing organizations, and patient reviews from The SafeCare Group’s www.rateahospital.com site were added.

Perhaps, one of the most readily notable changes was discontinuance of the annual Person of the Year. SafeCare magazine reluctantly made this decision with subscriber input as the number of candidates dwindled during the pandemic. There were also other changes.

Subscribers, especially non-hospital readers were interested in our annual Hospital of the Year. Very few other areas generated as much interest as this annual selection, and so the decision was made to expand the hospital selection areas. Instead of just focusing on the www.100safecarehospitals.com ratings, the publication included data from overseas hospitals as well. In 2023, a non-U.S. hospital earned the SafeCare Hospital of the Year for the first time coming off the pandemic.

As the world exited the pandemic, the editorial staff decided to give the magazine a facelift. After he COVID-19 Pandemic, the publication changed its course and diversified its content and has attracted a broader audience. It was decided that the cover photo would not be limited to people alone. Rather, cover photos moving forward would consist of people, places, causes, situations, and happenings. The title font was updated to read larger and bolder. Finally, in 2023, the decision was made to transform to a monthly publication.

Congratulations to SafeCare magazine on its 10th Anniversary.

Since the monthly edition, there has been a significant uptick of readership, even surpassing pre-pandemic levers.

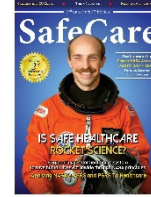

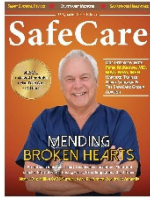

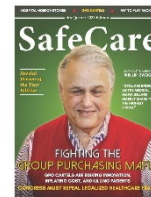
