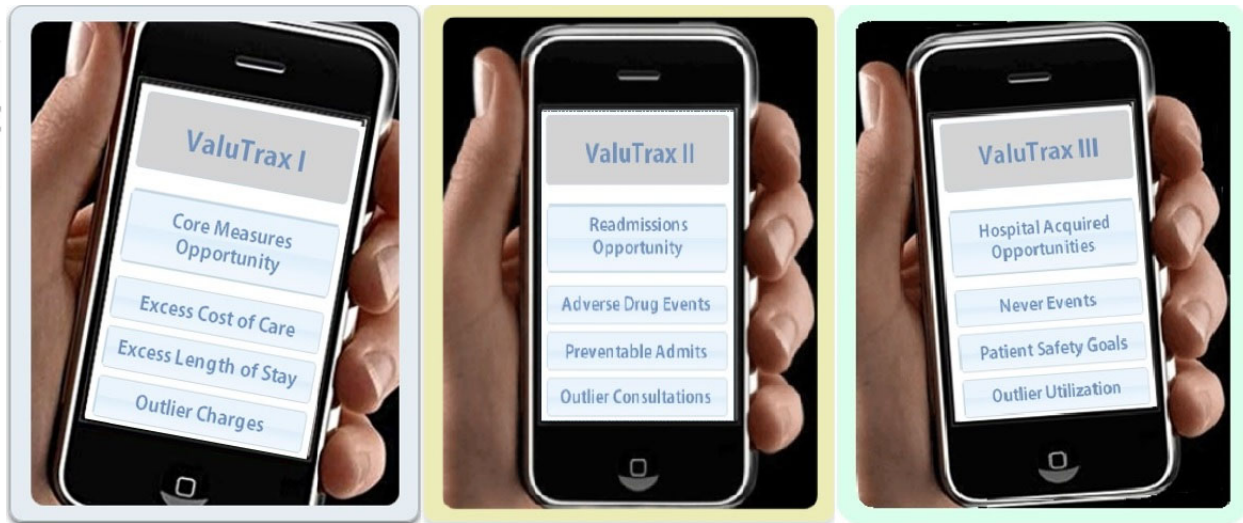

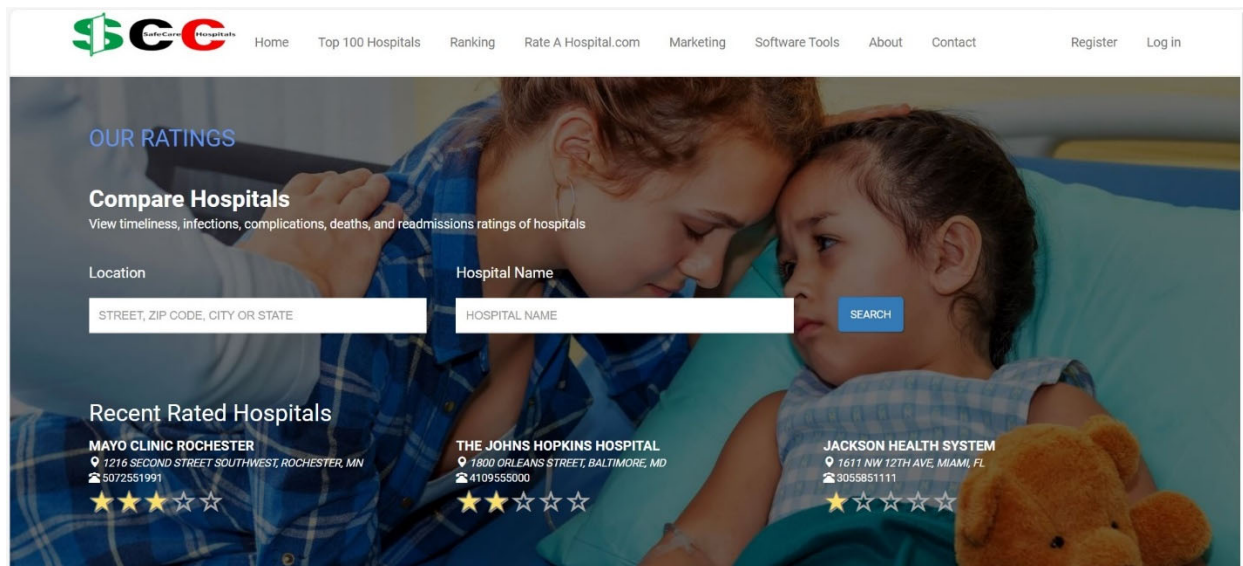

SafeCare AI®: Launched in 2016, this Platforms-as-a-Service leverages machine learning, deep learning, and artificial neural networks to analyze EMR data and deliver predictive, real-time clinical decision support.

These AI-powered, real-time clinical decision support that analyzes EMR (Electronic Medical Record) data to predict and improve patient outcomes - such as preventing sepsis, reducing unnecessary readmissions, minimizing inpatient mortality, and enhancing medication safety, while lowering hospital charges. We call these "Intelligent Healthcare™".

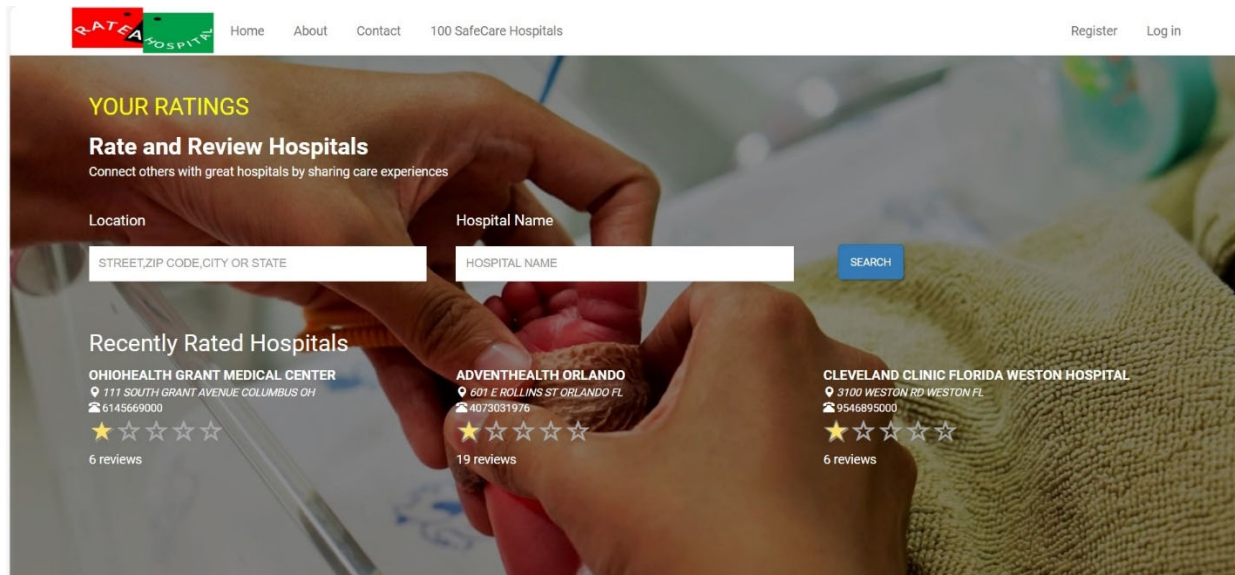
100 SafeCare Hospitals®: A ranking and rating system of the top U.S. hospitals based on metrics like patient outcomes, cost, safety, readmission rates, and infection rates. Since 2013, the Group has published quarterly evaluations of nearly 5,000 U.S. hospitals, including Veterans Affairs and military hospitals, with the “Top 50” representing the nation’s top 1%.



By leveraging AI, it is now possible to create more accurate, comprehensive hospital ratings that benefit patients, healthcare providers, and policymakers alike. In 2025, additional

measures were required for generative AI hospital ratings powered by Next-Gen Dedicated GPUs.

Rate A Hospital™: Introduced in 2019, this consumer-facing platform (RateAHospital.com) lets patients rate and review hospitals based on their experiences. The platform enables patients to leave reviews of about 5,000 U.S. hospitals, connecting experiences to future healthcare consumers across five key domains.



SafeCare® Magazine: Since 2015, the organization has published stories highlighting critical issues in the U.S. healthcare system - “telling the stories that deserve to be told - the story of the human condition across the globe.”

Milestones and Influence

Founded in 2010 by Yisrael M. Safeek, MD, MBA, the company began as a small SaaS startup and has grown into a comprehensive healthcare analytics provider. Its platforms and reports are designed to drive transparency, accountability, and improvement in hospital care quality across the U.S.A.

Recent Developments:

2020-2025: Marking its 15-year anniversary, The SafeCare Group continues to innovate. During the pandemic, several new board members were brought on including a seasoned local tech guru and a permanent Vice Chairman. The SafeCare Group’s workforce capacity with IT consulting, software deployment, and backup and recovery systems.

In 2025, The SafeCare Group released AI-powered hospital ratings utilizing next-generation generative models and GPUs, advancing its evaluations' accuracy, sophistication and timeliness. Seven (7) additional metrics were incorporated bringing the total to 54 metrics evaluated and processed quarterly in the areas of hospital charges, wait times, medical errors and deaths,

infections, and readmissions. The “Top 100 SafeCare Hospitals®” represent the top 1% of all U.S. hospitals

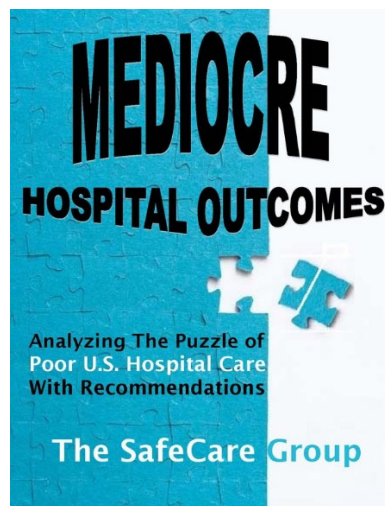
In 2025, The SafeCare Group was allowed access to SingHealth Quality Management Data and compared it with US hospitals data. Singapore General Hospital quality performance emerged as 2025 Hospital of the Year.

In 2025, Rate A Hospital dot com celebrated its 5th anniversary of receiving patient inputs. The service exists as an easy tool for hospital consumers to find, compare, and review hospitals. Over the past five years, the thousands of patient reviews have highlighted serious hospital care issues including unscrupulous billing, patient abandonment, long waits, excessive readmissions, and medical errors.

In 2025, SafeCare magazine celebrated its 10th Anniversary. Originally a quarterly publication, the magazine is now monthly. It has expanded readership with a revamped look and broader global topics that has attracted new readers.

In 2023, 100 SafeCare Hospitals® celebrated its 10th anniversary by updating its methodology to report on Hospital Charges and Medical Errors. In addition, a new linkage was established between www.rateahospital.com to www.100safecarehospitals.com. Anyone leaving a hospital review at Rate A Hospital can easily access The SafeCare Group’s rating of that specific hospital.

In 2022, The SafeCare Group released its seminal report *Analyzing The Puzzle of Poor U.S. Hospital Care With Recommendations*. The 2022 report from The SafeCare Group was designed to assess the largest U.S. hospital systems performance in relevant outcomes metrics.



A comparison analysis of various hospital systems was performed for the report. Hospital systems were compared based on similar number of hospitals within the corporate network, and matched up in five outcomes categories - timeliness, infections, complications, readmissions, and deaths). There were significant conclusions drawn from the findings in the report.

2010–2020: Marking its 10-year anniversary, The SafeCare Group celebrated its growth from an idea on a laptop into a powerhouse in healthcare AI and analytics. During this period, it launched multiple SaaS tools, its magazine, and AI capabilities, and submitted a seven-point plan to the White House to reform the healthcare system
